Friday 25 April 2008 - Day 1

You will be flown from OR Tambo International Airport to George International Airport and transferred with luxury coach to the 4-Star Oudshoorn Hotel and Resort where you will reside for the next four nights.

The Oudtshoorn Hotel & Resort lies in the centre of Oudtshoorn which is tucked away between the Outeniqua and Swartberg Mountains. Oudtshoorn is a must see destination with world class attractions like the famous and the Cango Caves, ostrich show farms and Cango wild life ranch.

The hotel's Garden Grill & Buffet restaurant offers a wide selection of international and traditional cuisine and tasty ostrich specialties. Lunch and dinner can be enjoyed on the Pool Terrace and the residents bar is the perfect place to relax after an action-packed day.

A Meet and Greet party will be held with a traditional Karoo braai.

Saturday 26 April 2008 - Day 2

Breakfast will be served at the hotel.

The day is yours and you can enjoy time in Oudtshoorn and experience a variety of attractions like historical buildings, Oudtshoorn artists and a township tour.

At the resort you can enjoy a relaxing massage at the Feathers Spa, swim, play tennis, play mini-golf or watch the sport on your own TV.

A visit to the Swartberg Mountains

The Swartberg mountain range stretches for 220 km and separates the semi deserts of the Klein and Great Karoo. The San named these mountains "Cango" which means water mountains. On the mountains many small brooks and rivers rise.

Swartberg Pass links up Prince Albert with the Klein Karoo region. It is known as one of the most spectacular mountain passes in Southern Africa. Travelling from Prince Albert you have to pass a canyon-like, narrow gorge and wind your way up to the top of the mountains (1.568m and about 1.220m above Oudtshoorn). Up in the mountains some nice proteas and other fynbos vegetation can be seen. From the top you can enjoy endless views over the Klein Karoo and the Outeniqua mountains towards the Indian Ocean. As this pass is not tarred it should not be driven in rainy ("snowy") weather. The Swartberg mountain is a hiker's paradise.

Lunch will be served at the famous "Kobus se gat" - a pub high up in the mountains.

On return to the hotel dinner will be served.

Tuesday 29 April 2008 - Day 5

After breakfast at the hotel we will check out. Transfer to the 4-star Wilderness Beach Hotel and Spa in the Wilderness.

Set against the backdrop of majestic mountains, with its prime position offering panoramic views of the Indian Ocean and overlooking miles of beautiful beaches, The Wilderness Beach Hotel is a perfect holiday destination.

Their wellness Centre also offers treatments for business and leisure travelers who simply wish to de-stress and be pampered, including yoga, massages and beauty treatments.

Golfers:

Golf (Round No 1) - Oubaai

It is the first golf course ever designed by Ernie Els. It is an 18-hole, par 72, classic links-style, Kikuyu with bent grass greens. It has magnificent views of the Outeniqua Mountains, natural forests, the Gwaing River Valley and Indian Ocean. Your round will be complemented with a cart and a halfway house lunch.

Golf (Round 2) - Simola Golf Estate

The first Jack Nicklaus Signature course on the Garden Route, Simola reflects the great maestro's philosophy of attuning the layout and design to the natural lie of the land.

Keeping your head down at Simola can be a challenge; simply because the views around the course are awe-inspiring, and with this, it is clear to see why Simola takes its place as one of South Africa's premier golfing destinations.

Your round will be complemented with a cart and a halfway house snack.

Non-golfers

The non-golfer will experience a visit to the Featherbed Eco-Reserve.

Featherbed is a privately-owned, registered Nature Reserve and a South African Heritage site, No.59. It is a pristine piece of paradise situated on the Western Head of Knysna and is accessible by ferry only. This spectacular four-hour eco-experience includes a return ferry trip, nature drive and guided walk, ending with a sumptuous buffet lunch at the Food Forest Restaurant.

Featherbed Nature Reserve is a prime example of eco-tourism and in order to protect the splendour of the natural beauty, access to the Reserve is controlled. Numbers are limited and visits are only permitted in the company of the Reserve's specialist guides.

The Featherbed eco-experience starts with a 25-minute ferry cruise. Your local guide on board will share fascinating tales about the Lagoon, the early shipping industry and oyster cultivation.

On arrival at the Reserve, visitors can enjoy a drive to the top of the Western Head in a 4 x 4 unimog vehicle with trailers, stopping at a magnificent view point en route. Here unsurpassed views of the Lagoon, mountains and Knysna can be enjoyed, whilst our knowledgeable guides explain the history and ecology of the Reserve. After the drive, your specialist guide will take you on an optional 2.2 kilometre downhill walk.

Dinner will be served at the hotel.

Thursday 1 May 2008 - Day 7
“Workers day for South Africans”

Breakfast served at the hotel.

A day in the Tsitsikamma forests. Join us, by going on the forest canopy tour. Not only is this an adventure like none other, but you also have the opportunity to see the forest from a birds eye view. An excellent excursion. A light meal will be served at the park.

We will visit the Storms River Bridge where the adventurer can do a walk over the bridge, do a fox fly under the bridge or do a bungee jump from Bloukrans, officially the world’s highest commercialized bungy jump - a whooping 216m high. (This will be for your own account - Bungy Jump R600, Flying Fox R150 and Bridge Walk R50)

Golf (Round 3) - Pezula Championship Course and Golf Club

Pezula Championship Golf Course adjacent to Pezula Resort Hotel & Spa is a sweeping spectacle of fairways and greens rolling through the pristine Southern Cape landscape. The breathtaking, award-winning 18-hole course which was designed by David Dale and Ronald Fream of GolfPlan USA, rates amongst the best and the most scenic golf courses in the world. In 2001, just a few months after it opened, the Course was awarded Best New Golf Course in South Africa. In February 2005 Compleat Golfer rated it a Five Star Golf Experience. It was also awarded:
